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This web-based application is essentially a combination of the exploration activities and planning modules available in Career Targets, Coin Jr., and the Individual Career Portfolios.

CTO presents users with two different means for completing the program. Students can walk-through the program step-by-step, only progressing once they taken an interest and skills assessment and have achieved mastery after certain exploration activities. Or, students can simply use the databases for quick reference searches.

Career Targets Online also features modules to help intermediate students begin the creation of Individual Graduation Portfolios (IGP), develop four-year high school course schedules, and record exploration and skill-building activities conducted in school and in extra-curricular experiences.

The website is divided into eight sections that address the following questions:

- What is a career?
- What are your interests and skills?
- How are occupations organized?
- What occupations relate to your interests?
- How can you build skills for a career?
- How can you select school classes to prepare for your career?
- How do you search for jobs?
- How do you continue your career exploration activities at the next level (high school)?

CTO offers a special administrative capability to turn access to features on/off and generate usage reports for individuals and groups. Supplemental activities, including ideas for project-based assessments are also provided.
